### Staffing & Central Analytics Team

- Ian Cope was appointed to the Chief Statistician post on a permanent basis in December
- Dan Edmunds was been appointed as deputy Chief Statistician on a permanent basis in April
- Sarah Davis has been appointed to lead the Central Analytics Team starting on 13 June Sarah is kicking off the process to recruit to the team
- Sarah will lead on admin data linkage, given her experience in this field
  - Looking to fill the fixed term posts to deliver this work
- Will bring the Central Analytics Team within the remit of the Statistics Law
  - To ensure that the powers and constraints of the Stats Law apply to the work of this team
- Also considering the name of this team to better reflect its function



#### **2021 Census publications**

- Statistics Jersey have prioritised publishing as much census data as possible in advance of the election period
- Bulletins 1-3 published before election period covering:
- 1. Population; Sexual Orientation; and Gender Identity
- 2. Housing and households
- 3. Health Characteristics

Further results will be released after the election period (after 12 July)

# Making briefing material publicly available

- Most briefing presentations simply summarise the key points from the statistical release
- Statistics Jersey will release briefing presentations where we judge that there is a significant public interest in the briefing (e.g. for census briefings) or where there is additional contextual material in the briefing
  - As has been done for the briefing for the first census release



#### **Codes of Practice**

- I was due to present to Executive Leadership Team on 9 March, but I asked for this to be delayed due to prioritising issues around release of the Children and Young Persons Survey and queries from one DG
- This was re-scheduled to 11 May, but I have again had to reschedule due to being at a Gartner 'Data and Analytics' conference in the UK
  - Now scheduled for 8 June
- Heads of Practice identified as Margi Clarke for Public Health
  - Others have not been designated yet, but I will be making recommendations to ELT where this is obvious e.g. Beverley Edwards for HCS, Suzie Philips for CYPE; Ross Nieuwberg for CLS, etc



### Admin data linkage project

- The funding for the Health Recovery admin data linkage business case was approved by the Political Oversight Group
- Agreed funding will provide money for four admin data linkage staff, plus licences etc
  - Also includes budget for M&D to build infrastructure
- Currently looking to recruit staff to do the data linkage work
- Margi recruiting staff for qualitative research; opened discussions with possible UK academic partners
- Workshops with M&D about data infrastructure; datasets that we need, etc




### **Average Earnings Index**

- Received a request from CLS on 29 April 2022 asking for a week's pre-release access to Average Earnings Index data
- I have responded in line with the SUG position from last year i.e. no pre-release access
- However, I expect to receive push-back from CLS

#### General election and statistics

- I have shared the election guidance with analysts across government
- The Pre-election period begins on 11 May <u>Standing in the 2022 General</u> <u>Election Vote.je States of Jersey Elections</u>

- During the election period Statistics Jersey will continue to publish pre-announced official statistics but will not publish ad-hoc stats
  - In practice only the Index of House Prices on 19 May falls within the election period
- Public Health will continue to publish regular weekly/monthly Covid statistics
- Statisticians and analysts should respond to FoI data requests as normal

### **Jersey Opinion and Lifestyle Survey 2022**

- As Gailina/Auberon are aware, we set up an JOLS advisory Group to advise on the content of the 2022 Survey. There have been two meetings:
  - Gailina attended the first; and Auberon the second.
- We have now finalised the content of the 2022 JOLS, which will take place immediately after the election (as it contains question on voting, at the request of the Greffe)



#### Release schedule

- A release schedule is required by the Code of Practice
  - International good practice is to have a rolling 12-month ahead release calendar
- The 2023 (first six months) release schedule was published in December <u>Publication release schedule (Statistics Jersey) (gov.je)</u>
  - Minor updates to the 2023 schedule no material change in content, but reflect updated dates / days of release
- A release schedule for the second six months of 2023 will be added to the schedule



#### **Cross-government data reporting**

- The Q4 2021 service performance measures were published on 15 February online <a href="Performance Measures 2021 (gov.je">Performance Measures 2021 (gov.je)</a>
  - And in the 2021 Annual Report and Accounts [link]
- Q1 2022 data will be published before the election
- The Island Outcomes and Indicators were updated in December
  - Going through process to update where data available during Q1 <u>Jersey's</u>
     <u>Performance Framework: measuring sustainable wellbeing (gov.je)</u>
- The Jersey in Figures webpage <u>Statistical data for Jersey (gov.je)</u>
  - Aiming to get as much updated as possible prior to the election period
